Title: Award of Contract for Commissioned Services Needs Assessment

Executive Summary:

The Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) for Dyfed Powys sets out his priorities for the period 2017-2021 in his Police and Crime Plan and details how he will commission services to support the people of the communities of both Dyfed and Powys. To enable the achievement of the priorities within this plan, the PCC has a statutory responsibilities to commission services to help make communities safer and to support victims and other vulnerable persons.

Currently, the PCC commissions individual services across a multitude of service providers, offering services to victims of crime and anti-social behaviour, individuals suffering with alcohol and substance misuse issues, victims of domestic abuse, victims of sexual abuse, as well as offering Restorative Justice services and a missing person de-briefing service for children and young people reported as missing. These services offer vital support to vulnerable people; however given the ever changing landscape of criminal activity and the changing complexity of victim's needs, there is a need to fully understand the needs of our communities to ensure that these services are meeting the current demand.

In order to ensure that we make the best use of resources across the Dyfed Powys area and effectively commission and target services based upon need, the PCC has chosen to commission a comprehensive Needs Assessment of the communities within the Dyfed-Powys area. It is intended that this will be used as the evidence base for future service configuration, commissioning and partnership arrangements. It will also look to identify where potential cross overs exist with government or partner funded initiatives, to allow the PCC to commission services to offer the best possible outcomes without creating duplications of effort.

Recommendation: That the PCC agrees for the contract for the above piece of work to be awarded to George Partnerships Ltd, as per the recent quotation process.
