Title: Extension of Victim Satisfaction survey contract

Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Commissioning

Executive Summary:

The Police and Crime Commissioner awarded a contract to Dyfed Powys Police in April 2017 to undertake victim satisfaction surveys. This contract ran for a 3 year initial period, with 2 options to extend for a further 12 months each. Following a discussion at Policing Board on 4th July 2019, it was agreed to pursue conversations at an All Wales level to propose a future process for conducting victim satisfaction surveys. This will allow a consistent approach, along with comparable performance information and learning to be shared across the region. In line with this, victim satisfaction will be an agenda item on the All Wales Policing Group meeting scheduled for September 2019.

To ensure local services are protected whilst All Wales discussions are held, and to provide consistency into the new PCC term commencing in May 2020, it is advised that the PCC call upon the first extension for the above mentioned contract; extending the contract to end on 31/03/2021. The total annual value of the contract for service provision is £20,000. There will be no scope to increase this during the extension period. The terms and conditions applicable during the period of extension will be the same as those which presently prevail for the current contract.

Recommendation:

That the PCC approves the call off for an additional period of 12 months for the victim satisfaction contract, taking it to 31/3/2021.
