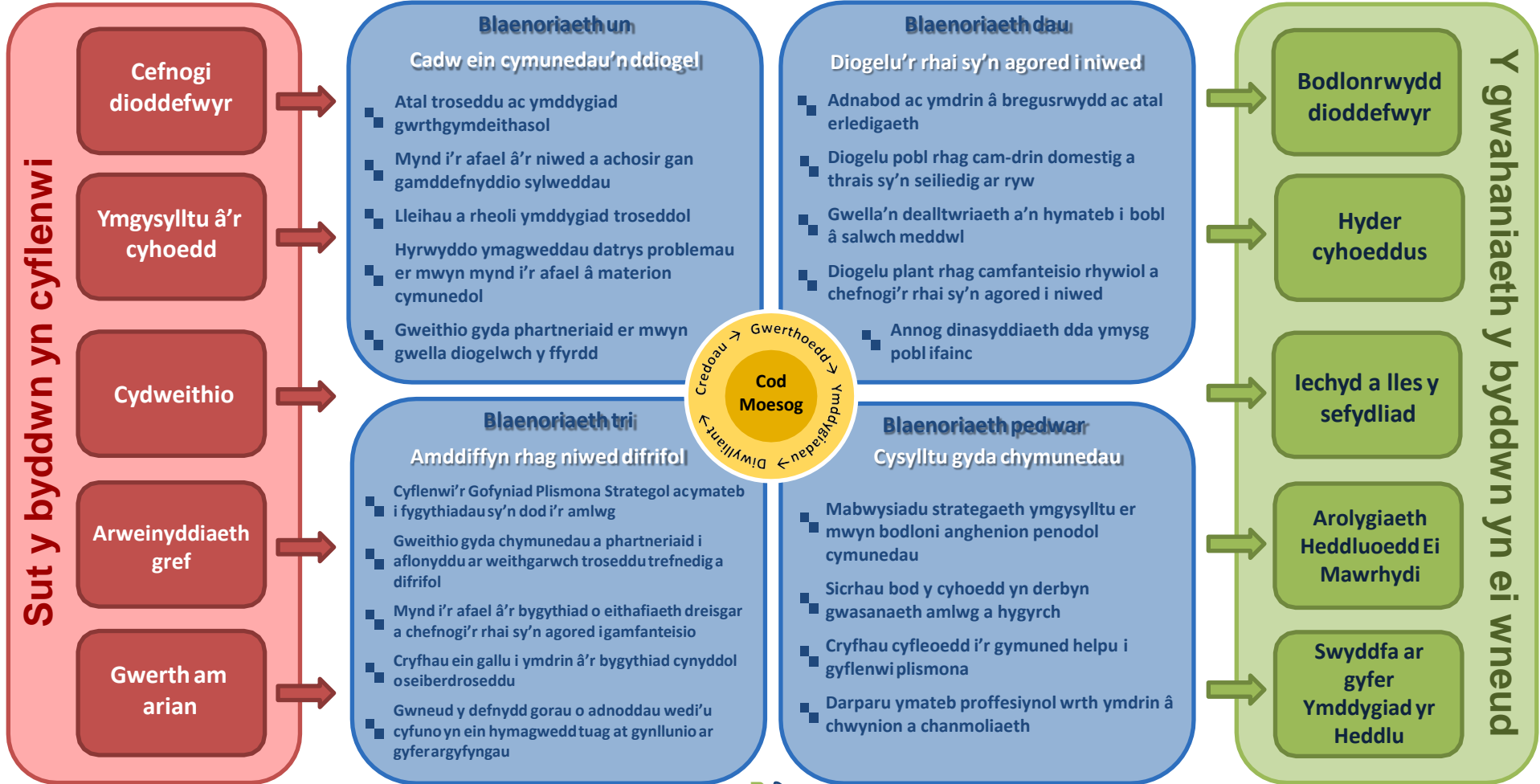

Priority one

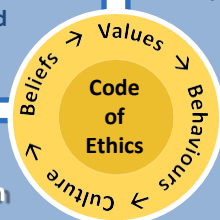
Keeping our communities safe

- Tackle the harm caused by substance misuse
- Reduce and manage offending behaviour
- Promote problem-solving approaches to address community issues
- Work with partners to improve road safety

Priority two

Safeguarding the vulnerable

- Recognise and deal with vulnerability and prevent victimisation
- Protect people from domestic abuse and gender-based violence
- Enhance our understanding and our response to people with mental ill health
- Safeguard children from sexual exploitation and support those who are vulnerable
- Encourage positive citizenship in young people



Priority three

Protecting from serious harm

- Deliver the Strategic Policing Requirement and respond to emerging threats
- Work with communities and partners to disrupt serious and organised crime activity
- Address the threat of violent extremism and support those vulnerable to exploitation
