Title: Approval of Carmarthenshire SCB submitted bids

Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Finance

Executive Summary:

Carmarthenshire Safer Communities Board submitted 2 bids to the already allocated £25k funding earmarked for Community Safety Partnerships. The bids asked for funding to purchase new target hardening equipment for rural communities to reduce acquisitive crime and increase community safety. The technology is called LoRaWAN and will be distributed to rural properties Long Range Wide Area Network (LoRaWAN) technology and it will be used different types of electronic methods and sensors to collect data. The funding request is for up to £15k.

The second bid request is to arrange the implementation of 'no cold calling' zones in rural communities and will purchase signs to be set up. The request was for £1050.

Both bids were scored and passed the initial scoring process, and the PCC has decided to support both bids, with funding coming from the Driver retraining reserves.

Recommendation: To approve the submitted bids from Carmarthenshire Safer Communities Board.
