Title: Match funding towards Safer Streets 2 project

Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Finance / grants

Executive Summary:

The OPCC in partnership with the Force, Llanelli Town Council and Carmarthenshire County Council were successful in obtaining funding from the Home Office Safer Streets fund round 2. A total of just over £87,000 has been awarded for the period April 2021 to March 2022.

The project will be focussed on tackling all neighbourhood crime including vehicle crime, burglary, robbery and theft from a person within the identified areas of Tyisha 2 and Elli 2. From extensive consultation with key partners and the community, the following interventions will be delivered to assist in tackling the identified problem of all acquisitive crime – the employment of community wardens, the purchase of SelectaDNA kits and bike register kits, environmental improvements and additional street lighting columns, the roll out of a small community grants programme managed via the Carmarthenshire Safer Communities Board, whereby local community groups in the area can build their capacity to deliver future crime prevention projects and develop future support for the groups.

In order for the bid to be accepted, the Home Office included a requirement for match funding. It is recommended that the PCC approves the use of £21,834 from the Driver Retraining Reserves to enable this project to be delivered.

Recommendation:

The PCC approves a contribution of £21,834 match funding to deliver the Safer Streets Fund 2 from the Driver Retraining Reserves.
