Executive Summary:

Following consideration of business requirements, it was identified that a Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner was needed within the OPCC to lead, on the Commissioner's behalf, in scrutinising the management and financial performance of the police and all crime prevention services across Dyfed-Powys; to support to establishment of my office as a visible, influential and respected body with the public and within the police; with an ability to drive changes to organisation, management and culture within the police and partners.

A total of 11 applications were received, of which 4 were invited to interview. These were from a diverse background, with a range of experience and skills. Following a thorough and robust process, a decision that Mr Tim Burton, currently Chief Operating Officer at SLL, should be appointed as the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner was unanimously supported by the advisors on the Appointments Panel.
