Response to the multi-agency response to child sexual abuse in the family environment report

I welcome the Inspectorates' calls for child sexual abuse in the family to be given greater priority. Children should be safe in their own homes, free from fear and harm. This is why I am committed to improving how child victims of crime are responded to and supported.

I have made a commitment to fund a new child victim support role to work closely with Dyfed-Powys Police's victim and witness care service, Goleudy. I will be looking to this role to take note of the observations made within the report, and will be monitoring the difference the role makes to the most vulnerable child victims in our area.
