Title: The Game Change Project funding

Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Finance

Executive Summary:

The Game Change Project approached the Police & Crime Commissioner requesting funding of £19,593.00 as a 12-month contribution to their Achieve programme.

This programme supports 14–18-year-olds in Powys, who are disengaged, or at risk of disengaging from education. Achieve will build on a successful pilot project delivered during the autumn 2025. Through this pilot, referral pathways have been established with relevant partners including local policing.

The project will support vulnerable young people who have experienced trauma, low self-esteem, poor mental health, parental health/addiction, school exclusion, financial difficulties and rural isolation which leads greater risk of sexual exploitation, county lines, abuse, and sexual harassment.

The project will work with Police and partners to deliver activities which promote citizenship and offer a diversion from criminal activity.

The service supports the Police and Crime Plan priority: preventing harm.

Recommendation:

To provide funding of £19,593.00 from the Innovation Fund budget to the Game Change project as a contribution to their Achieve activity.
