MISSING YOUNG PEOPLE'S DEBRIEF SERVICE

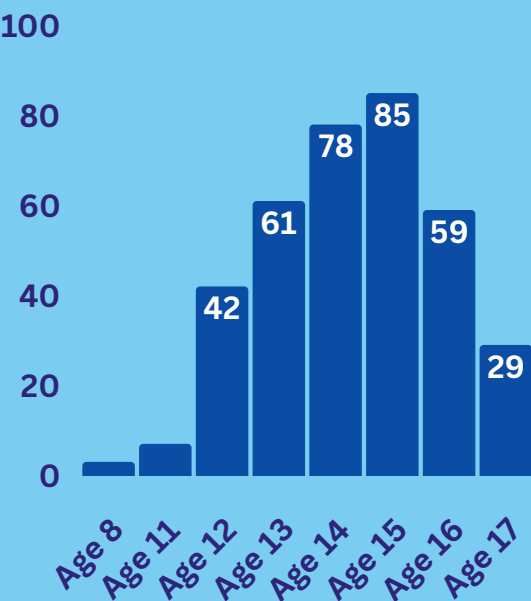
Llamau provide a high quality independent de-briefing and mediation service for children and young people who have been reported as 'missing' within Dyfed Powys Police area. The service provides direct support to the young person, family mediation and group work as appropriate, along with referrals for specialist support from partner agencies.

£93,000 per annum.

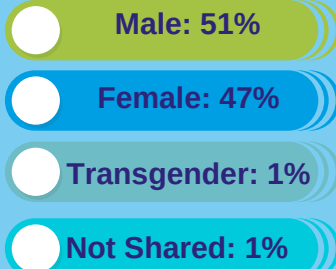
STATISTICS

Age of referrals:



During 2024/2025 there were: 369 referrals for debrief
245 debrief sessions completed by Llamau (first time and repeats)
123 debriefs were declined/inappropriate

Gender:



Top 5 reasons for going missing:

1. Wanted to be with friends/ peer pressure
2. Didn't think they were missing
3. Needed time out
4. Not happy/ issues in school
5. Arguments at home / boundaries

Number of debriefs where risks of child sexual exploitation were identified: 56

Number of safeguarding referrals: 90

"My son benefitted by talking to you, and understands the risks he put himself in by going missing."

"It made me aware of safety issues, and how my mother felt when I went missing."

"I'm so glad we talked. I don't know what I would have done without you!"

"I wouldn't have had the confidence to go to seek help from professionals if we hadn't spoken – thank you!"
