Title: Funding towards PSA (Prostate-Specific Antigen) testing

Category of Decision / Business Area Impact: Finance

Executive Summary:

Dyfed Powys Police and the Police Federation have approached the Police & Crime Commissioner to collaborate with them to support with the cost of delivering PSA (Prostate-Specific Antigen) testing for all eligible participants employed by Dyfed Powys Police and the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner. The contribution requested from the Commissioner is £1,620.00.

The jointly funded approach will enable eligible staff and officers aged 45+ to participate via a home testing kit administered by the Graham Fulford Charitable Trust. The home testing kits enable participants to have a simple blood test that may indicate whether or not they have a possible problem with their prostate and should take further action via their GP.

The cost of the activity includes test access (including booking service), distribution, laboratory analysis, results reporting and marketing materials to promote the service.

Recommendation:

To provide a contribution of £1,620.00 towards PSA Testing costs from the Innovation Fund budget.
