Operating in Carmarthenshire, Ceredigion, and Pembrokeshire, Dyfed Drug and Alcohol Service (DDAS) aims to reduce substance misuse-related harm to service users, significant others and the wider community. DDAS also works to identify and engage offenders from the point of arrest through to sentence, and to maximise the proportion of individuals


reducing their substance use and offending behaviour.




STATISTICS
